For emergencies that require EMS assistance

You are located at Joaquin Rocks in the far eastern section of the Bureau of Land Management's – Clear Creek Management Area.

For EMS evacuation, you need a CALSTAR evacuation helicopter sent from Gilroy, California to our location.

Contact Emergency Services by Using:

- **Cell Phone** Reliable cell phone coverage is available in the following areas:
 - Along most of the ridge as you enter Joaquin Flat from the access road.
 - On the N.E. side of Joaquin Rock when in view of the San Joaquin Valley.
 - Along any ridge or rock that provides a view of highway 5
 - Spotty cell phone coverage is available in Joaquin Flats and Joaquin Camp.

DIAL 911

When calling 911 from a cell phone you are talking to a California Highway Patrol (CHP) emergency operator. The CHP operator has no way of knowing who you are or from where you are calling. You must calmly provide every detail associated with your emergency in order for the operator to assist you.

- **Leave to seek help** If no cell phone is available then you must leave the area to seek help.

While Waiting for Emergency Services:

- Administer proper first aid.
- Get the patient out of danger.
- Continue proper first aid until Emergency Services arrive.
- Have someone watch for the EMS helicopter.
- Ignite smoke flare when EMS helicopter comes into view.

 - 8.86 miles magnetic south (185.8°) from the Interstate Highway 5 / State Highway 33 junction.
 - We will provide _____ colored smoke flare marker (*available from marine supply*)
